

## **New Year's Eve 2011**

The "foot print" of the New Year's Eve Firework display is growing every year and now encompass the Blackfriars area as well as large parts of Westminster, Southwark and Lambeth, impacting more on the City than in previous years. Around 500,000+ people are estimated to attend the event but with numerous other venues' in central London holding events this figure could be much higher.

The attached colour coded map shows the affected area and also provides indicative times of when road closures will be put in to effect. The areas marked red will be closed to traffic from approximately 4 pm, those in blue 5 pm, yellow 8 pm and green areas 10 pm. The green area extends to Newgate Street and St Paul's in the City.

Stewards assisted by the police will move crowds along the Strand into Fleet Street and via Ludgate Circus away from the viewing areas, they then walk via Ludgate Hill to St Pauls Churchyard and Cannon Street to access Mansion House and Bank Tube stations.

Access to residents of the green area will be allowed where possible unless there are crowd movements which prevent this.
