## Chestnut Trail

This circular route follows the main tracks in this historic park with some sections across open grassland. It is mostly flat with a few gentle inclines.

### Start point:

Warren Road entrance

### Time:

Approximately 2 hours

### Distance:

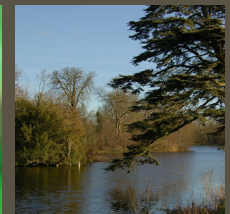
3.25 miles / 5.2km



The Grotto, first designed as an ornamental boat house, is a beautiful remnant from the past, and a fascinating example of 18th century garden landscaping.



Chalet Wood is blooming with bluebells, a member of the lily family, in spring time. For just a few short weeks you will see their stunning colours.



On the walk, you'll see the Ornamental Water, Heronry Pond and Perch Pond. Water bodies in parks allow beautiful views and encourage wildlife.
