
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


# Spines and Boundaries

Establishing a grid based on northsouth and east-west routes that can act as both boundaries and central spines to define areas.






### Focal Areas v3

Draft focal areas defined based on the established grid and connected via central character spines. Areas are aligned with zones for public realm activation outlined in the CPR vision.


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
Spines (as defined in public realm vision)


Activation areas (as defined in public realm vision)
