

Proposed Submission Draft City Plan 2040 Statement of Representations Procedure and Notification of Public Consultation

1. Title of the Plan: City Plan 2040

Notice is hereby given that the City of London Corporation has published and is inviting comments on its Regulation 19 Publication City Plan 2040 which it intends to submit to the Secretary of State for Levelling-up, Housing and Communities for independent examination.

2. Subject Matter and the area covered by the Plan

The City Plan 2040 will cover the whole administrative area of the City of London. The City Plan 2040 sets out the development strategy, vision, policies and proposals for planning in the City of London up to 2040 and beyond. It includes development management policies that will be used to guide decisions on planning applications.

The City Plan 2040 is accompanied by a Policies Map which shows the policy designations.

Upon its adoption, the City Plan 2040 will replace the adopted City of London Local Plan 2015.

The City Plan 2040 Proposed Submission Document takes account of responses from the Issues and Options (19 September to 2 December 2016), Regulation 18 public consultation (12 November 2018 to 28 February 2019), Proposed Submission Draft City Plan 2026 (19 March to 7 May 2021) and other informal engagement carried out in Summer 2023.

3. Period for making representations

Representations on City Plan 2040 must be received between **Thursday 18 April** and **31 May 2024** at **11:00pm**. Only representations made before the close of the consultation will be taken into account in the examination process.
