## **NOTES**

- 1. For the purposes of the Act, the term 'Society' includes any club, institution, organisation or association of persons, by whatever name called, and any separate branch or section of such club, institution, organisation or association.
- 2. The Society must be a Society established and conducted wholly or mainly for one or more of the following purposes:
  - (a) charitable purposes:
  - (b) participation in or support of athletic sports or games or cultural activities:
  - (c) other purposes not being purposes of private gain or purposes of any commercial undertaking:

and the lottery must be promoted for raising money to be applied for purposes of the Society.

- 3. The promoter must be a member of the Society and must be authorised in writing by the governing body of the Society to act as such.
- 4. The governing body of the Society must authorise in writing two persons over 18 years of age (other than the promoter) to certify the return to the Local Authority following the date of the Lottery. This return must be forwarded by no later than the end of the third month after the date of the lottery.
- 5. The registration may be cancelled at any time upon written notification being given by the Society to the Common Council.
- 6. The "date of a lottery" means the date on which the winners in that lottery are ascertained.
- 7. Societies are required to register in the relevant Local Council area where their head office is situated. Therefore for the purposes of this application, the address of the society's head office must be situated within the City of London area.
- 8. If, after registration, the Society's office is re-located to an address outside the City of London the registration must be surrendered in writing, and a new application should be made to the appropriate local authority.
