The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Amendment No. 20) (Cheapside) Order 2025

Made: 3rd April 2025

Coming into operation: 6th May 2025

The Common Council of the City of London, after consulting the Commissioner of Police for the City of London, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**) and section 8 of, and Part I of Schedule 5 to, the Local Government Act 1985(**b**), and of all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Amendment No. 20) (Cheapside) Order 2025 and shall come into operation on 6th May 2025.
- 2. In this Order, "enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument, having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by of any subsequent enactment.
- Whilst this Order remains in force, without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2019 (as amended)(c) shall have effect as though The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Cheapside) (Amendment No. 6) Order 2023 is hereby revoked in its entirety.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order further amends The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2019 (as amended), by revoking the no entry traffic restriction (except buses and pedal cycles) on a section of Cheapside that lies east of its junction with Bread Street. It makes the provisions of The City of London (Cheapside) (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (No. 17) Experimental Order 2023 permanent.
