Primrose Hill - Introduction of a 'no motor vehicles' restriction.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 22C, 22D and 124 of, and Part I of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other powers, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London, has made the order set out in section 1 to this notice, with the effect set out in section 2 to this notice.

1. The City Corporation has made the following order, which shall become effective on 30th April 2026; The City of London (Prescribed Routes) (No Motor Vehicles) (No. 1) Order 2026
2. The order set out in section 1 to this notice will have the following effect:
The Order introduces a 'no motor vehicles at any time' restriction on the length of **Primrose Hill** that lies north of the northern flank wall of number 22 Whitefriars Street.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make an application for the purpose to the High Court.
