**Colour by Light by Floating Pictures: St Mary Le Bow Church, Cheapside EC2V 6AU**  
Get creative with a smartphone torch or any source of light and turn the area into your own colourful canvas.

**Celestial Brainstorm by Amelia Kosminky:**  
**Bloomberg Public Plaza, 3 Queen Victoria Street EC4N 8AR**  
Pull on the rope and this floating sculpture propels glittering neurons into the night sky.

**Imminence by Novak in collaboration with Ed Carter and Hazel Dunn:**  
**St. Paul's Churchyard (North side, by Temple Bar) EC4M 8AD**  
Reflect on the consequences of climate change as a vibrant projected landscape unfolds beneath your feet, accompanied by an original soundscape.

**Keys of Light\* by Mr.Beam: Guildhall Yard, off Gresham Street EC2V 5AE**  
Each note played on the grand piano generates a pulse of light, transforming the architecture of the Guildhall into a constantly evolving artwork.\*Closed on 16 & 17 Feb.

**Harmonic Portal by Chris Plant: St Mary Aldermary Church, 69 Watling St EC4N 4SJ**  
Piece together our fragmented world through a meditative exploration of the three frequencies used by our brains to create colour.

**One New Change** A fantastic shopping centre in the heart of the Cheapside area of the City featuring a roof terrace with views of St Paul's as well as 60 stores and a host of restaurants.
