

TOWER BRIDGE BY UZO EGONU

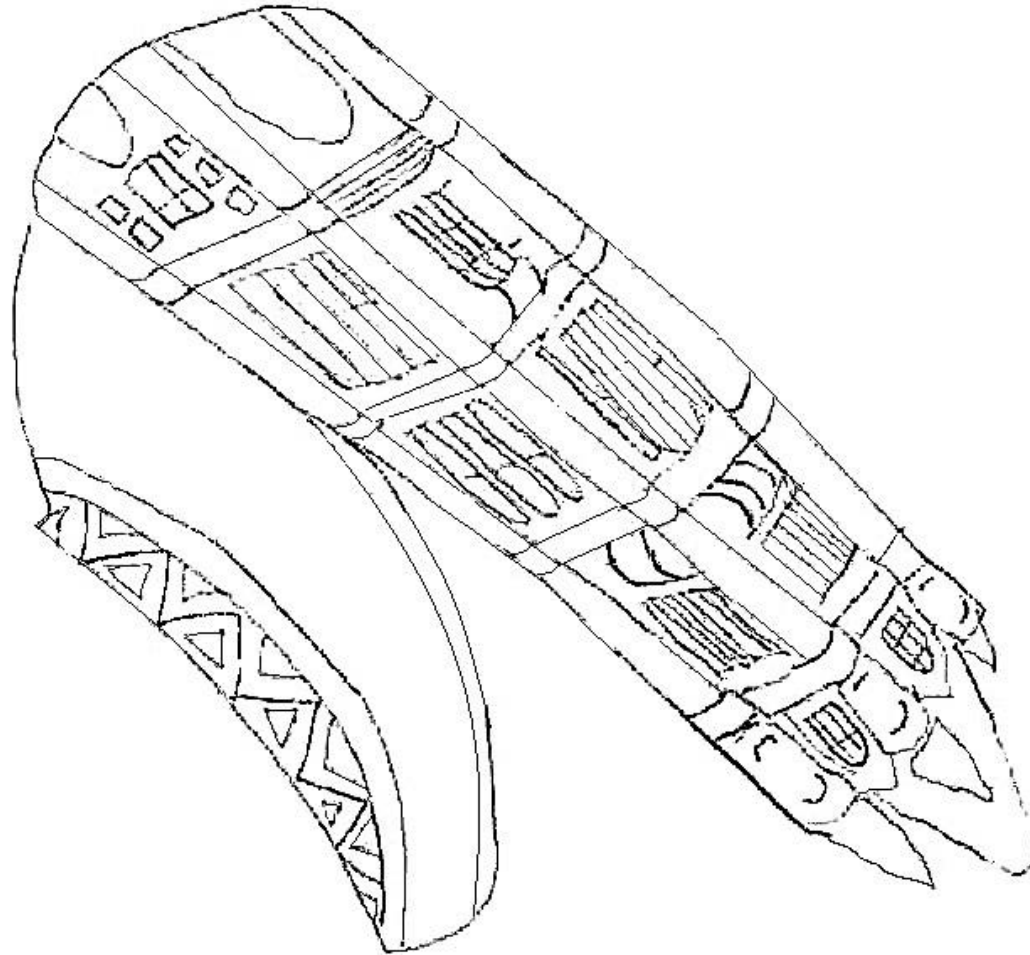

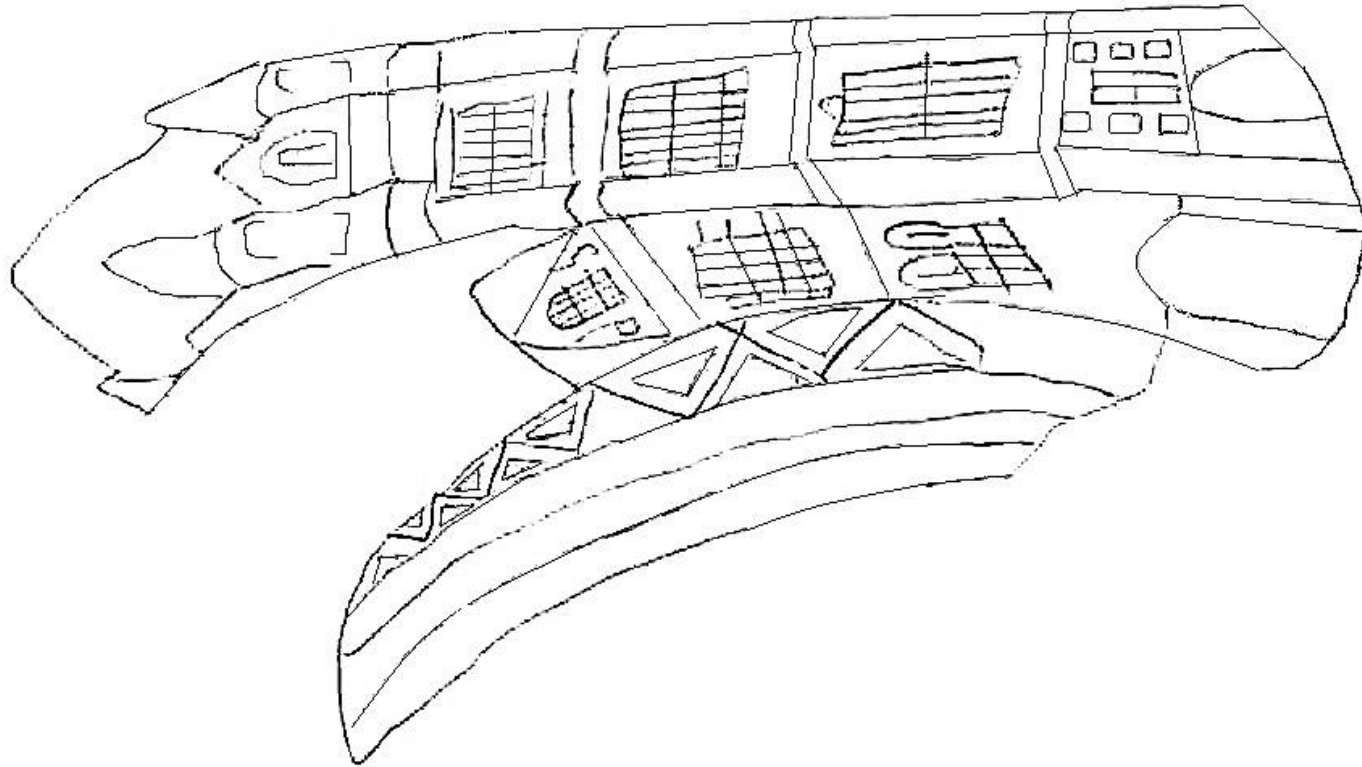

We have broken down Tower Bridge into several pieces for you to colour in and arrange in your own way.



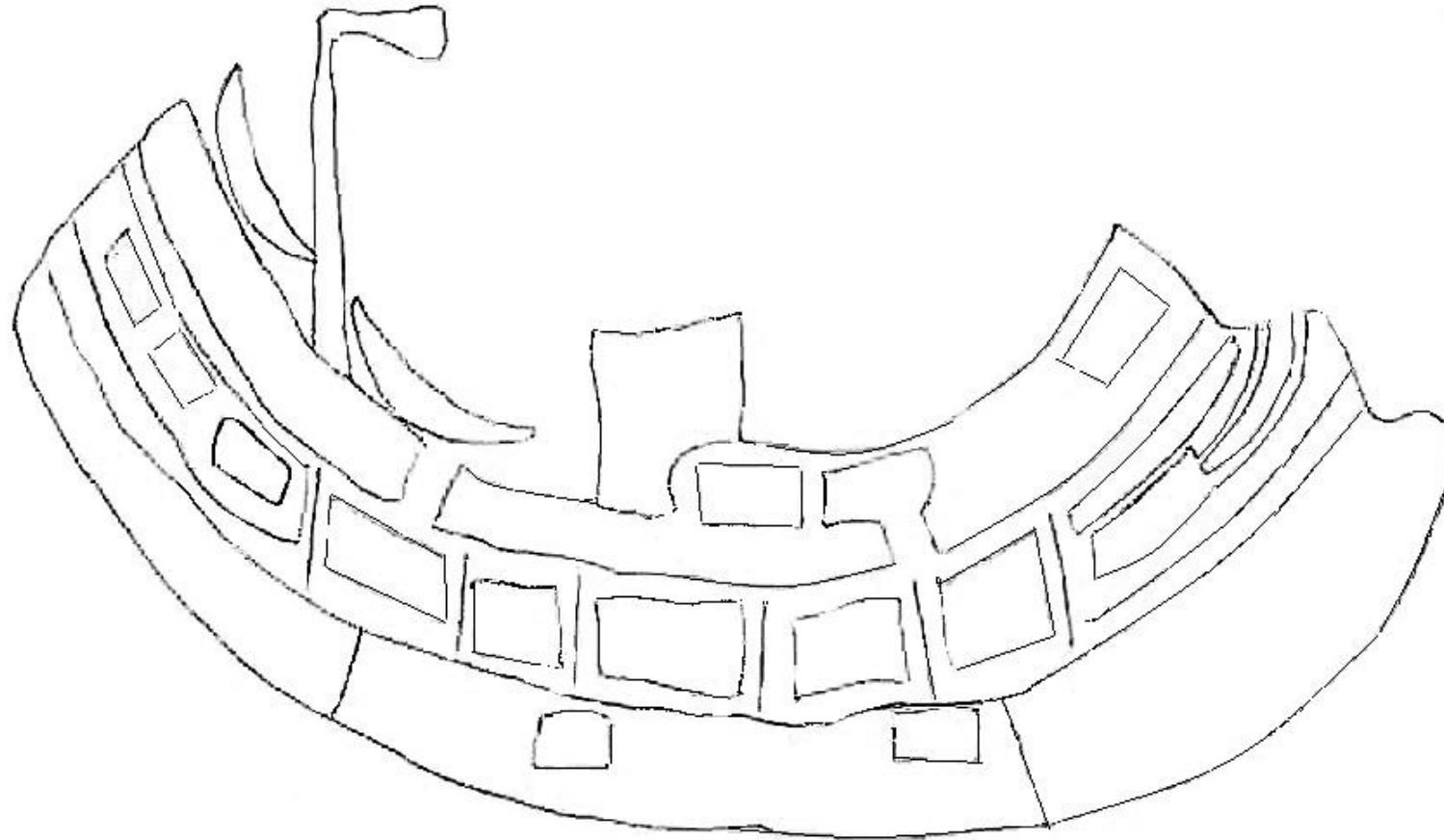

Colour them in, cut them out and make your own painting of Tower Bridge.



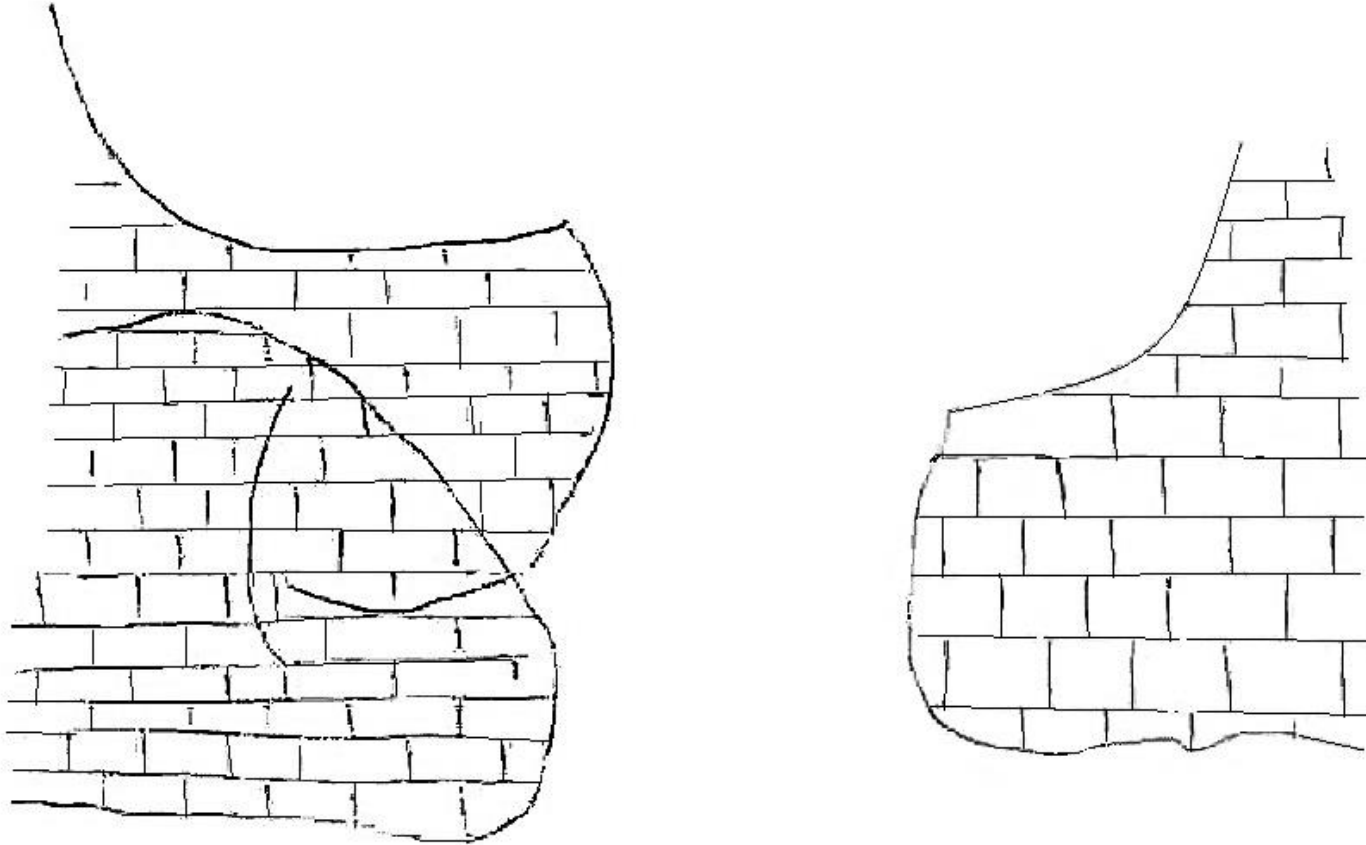
