

# Make your own model of a Roman Baths

Make your own model of a Roman baths like the one in the picture below. This is the hot room or *caldarium* of the baths that was heated by a furnace and had underfloor heating and hot air circulating through the walls.

Using the picture of the baths on the next page carefully follow the instructions below. As you will need some glue and a pair of scissors you may need an adult to help you with this.

1. Carefully cut around the picture of the baths.
2. Add colour or any other details to your model
3. Fold the paper along the lines between the arrows. Fold over flaps (coloured in grey).
4. Next use some glue or tape to stick flap 1 to the opposite wall of the baths.
5. Then stick flap 2 on to the opposite wall of the baths.
6. Then fold over the roof of the baths and glue flap 3.
