

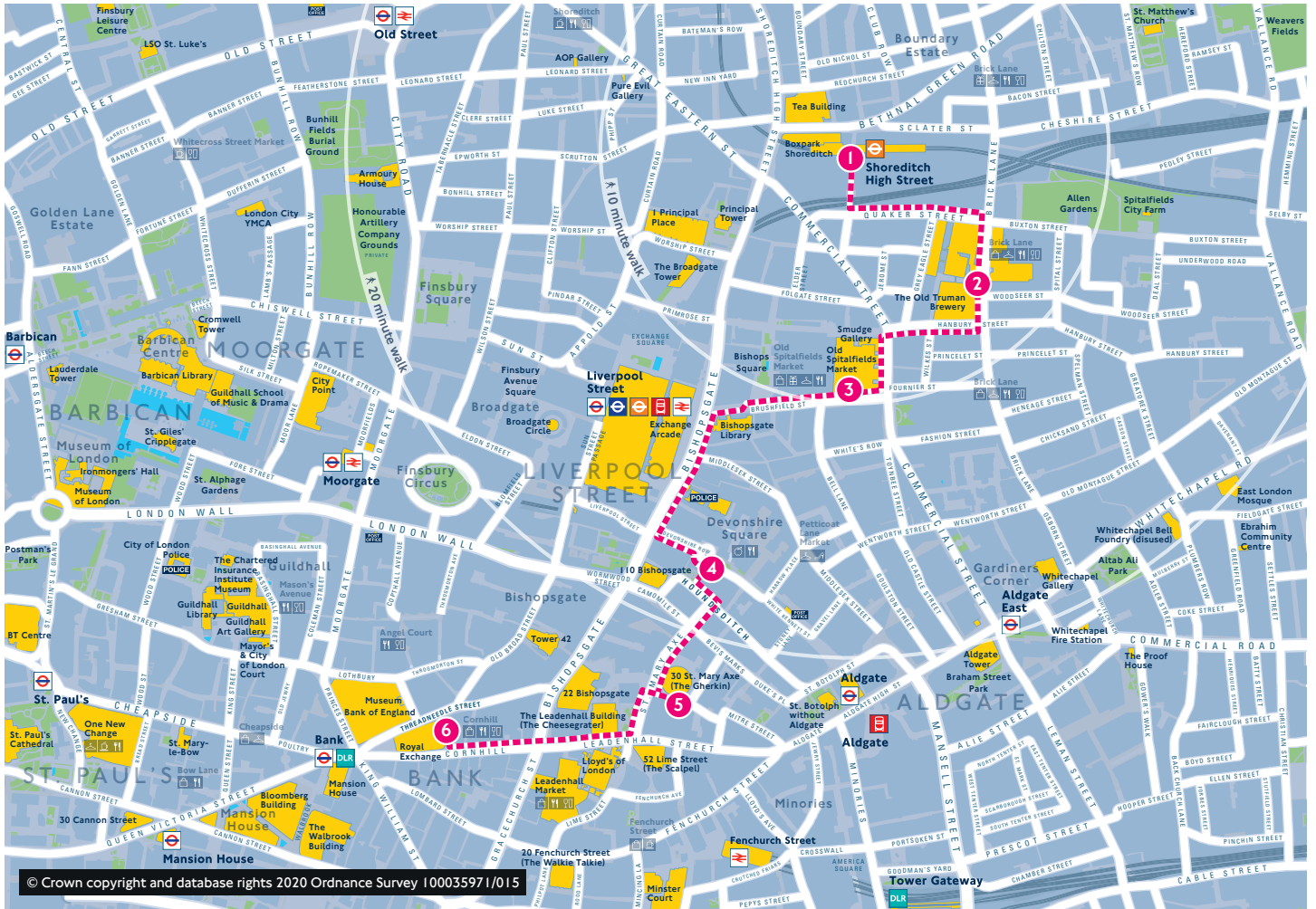
From the suburbs to the City



Escape the crowds of your local neighbourhood and adventure close to home walking in the City of London. Take lesser-trodden paths and uncover centuries of history, art and culture along the way on these walks designed to offer safe and fun ways for you to enjoy and explore London.

When you reach the City there is plenty to explore in the ancient heart of the capital. You don't need to travel to Italy to see Roman ruins or France to experience cafe culture. Grab a coffee in Bloomberg Arcade and watch the world go by, or marvel at the remains of the Roman Amphitheatre under Guildhall Yard.

Tower Hamlets to the City - Station to Station

Travel through the centuries between Shoreditch and Bank

1 **Shoreditch High Street Station**
Start of the walk. A station here since 1840 this one opened in 2011 and is built on stilts

4 **Devonshire Square**
The East India Company Warehouse, where expensive goods from all over the world were stored

2 **The Old Truman Brewery**
Beer brewed (and drunk) here for over 300 years

5 **The Gherkin**
A modern City icon next to an ancient church

3 **Spitalfields Market**
Once London's busy fruit and veg market. Now a great place to relax

6 **Royal Exchange**
End of the walk

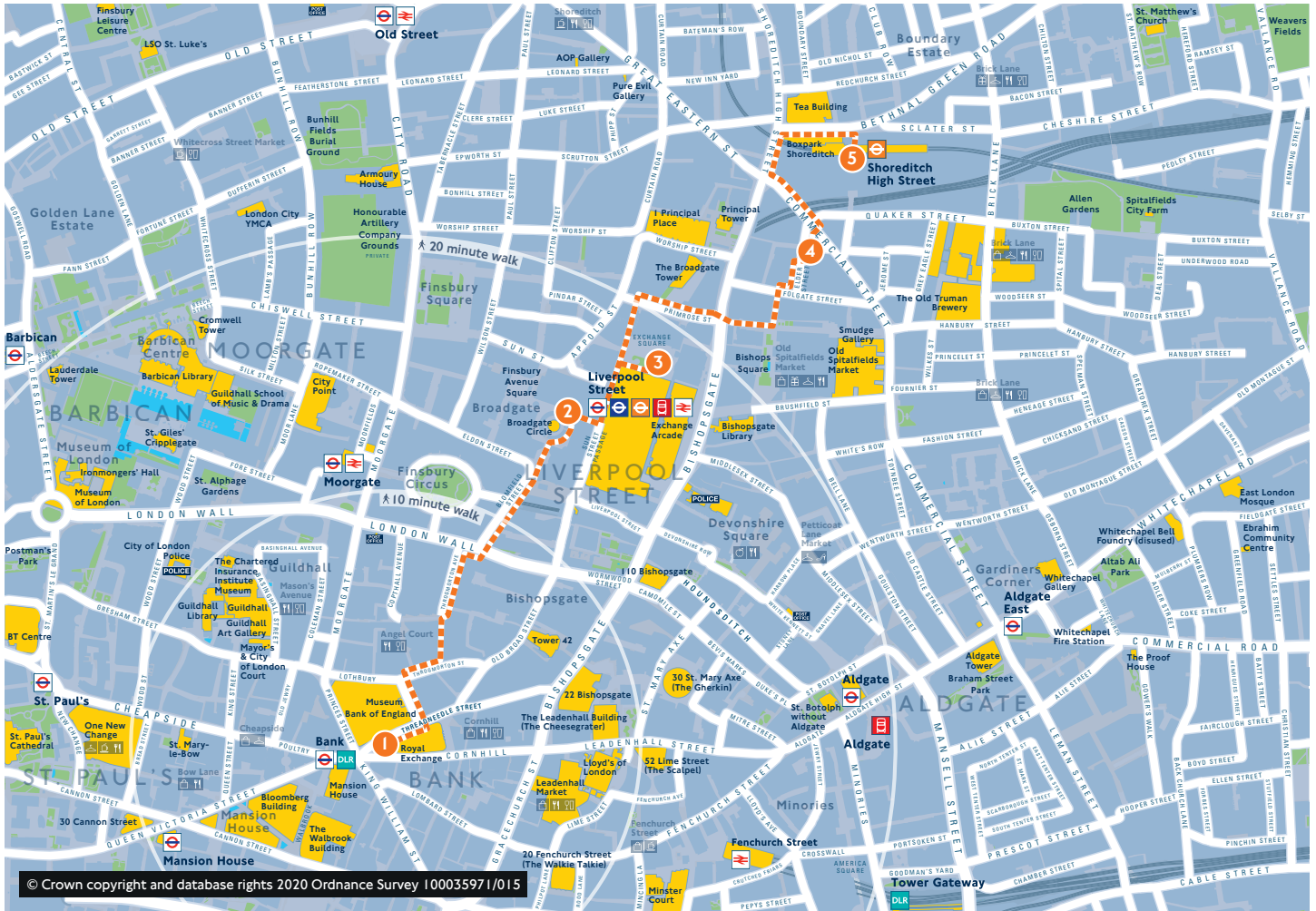
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The City to Tower Hamlets - Station to Station

Travel through the centuries between Bank and Shoreditch

1 Bank of England
Start of the walk. The central bank of the United Kingdom and the model on which most modern central banks have been based

4 Elder Street
Elegant Georgian houses where silk weavers lived

2 Broadgate Circus
A modern development constantly reinventing itself

5 Shoreditch High Street Station
End of the walk

3 Exchange Square
A hidden square with a great view of trains
