The City of London's Publication Scheme Guidance Document

[1] The Freedom of InformationAct 2000

The Freedom of Information Act ('FOIA') received Royal Assent on 30 November 2000. It gives a general right of access to all types of recorded information held by public authorities. It sets out exemptions from that right and places a number of obligations on public authorities. Under the FOIA public authorities are required to adopt and maintaina PublicationScheme.

[2] What is a Publication Scheme and Guidance Document?

A Publication Scheme has to set out what information a public authority will make available as a matter of course, how and when it will do so, and whether or not this information will be made available free of charge. The public authority must then release the information as promised in its Scheme. The Scheme should make sure that a significant amount of information is readily available to the public.

From 1 January 2009 the Information Commissioner, using his powers under section 19 of the FOIA, required public authorities to adopt his Model Publication Scheme, and this can be found on our Access to Information website pages (www.cityoflondon.gov.uk)

Being a 'model' issued by the Commissioner specifically for use by public authorities, it is not required to be amended or submitted to the Commissioner for approval. It is a commitment document, committing a public authority to proactive publication of the classes of information listed in the Model.

In addition, in operating the Model Publication Scheme, the Commissioner requires public authorities to provide a "guide to information" giving details of the information it will routinely make available; how the information can be accessed; and whether or not a charge will be made for it. The Information Commissioner has advised that a Guidance Document may take the form of a website, a spreadsheet or a leaflet.

In addition, the Commissioner has produced 'definition documents' as guides as to what different public authorities should more specifically be aiming to provide underthe modelScheme.

The term 'publication' is not limited to its traditional meaning, i.e. information contained in a bound or printed form as a brochure or a book. It covers anything

made public, including web-based information, one-off printed documents from a desktopPC,electronicdocuments,printedbooks, reports and leaflets.

[3] About the City of London

The City of London (also known as the City of London Corporation) provides local government services for the financial and commercial heart of Britain, the 'Square Mile' and additionally undertakes other publicand private functions.

The City of London is older than Parliament itself and today combines its ancient traditions and ceremonial functions with the role of a modern and efficient local authority, looking after the needs of its residents, City businesses and over 320,000 people who come to work in the City every day. Amongst authorities with local authority functions the City of London is unique: not only is it the oldest in the country but it operates on a non-party political basis, through its Lord Mayor, Aldermen and members of the Court of Common Council. The Lord Mayor, in particular, plays an important diplomatic role with his overseas visits and functions at the historicGuildhall and Mansion Housefor visitingheadsof State.

In addition to the usual services provided by a local authority, such as housing, refuse collection, education, social services, environmental health and town planning, the City of London performs a number of special functions. It runs its own police force (separate from the Metropolitan Police) and is the police authority for that force, and also runs the nation's Central Criminal Court, the Old Bailey. It maintains five major bridges which cross the River Thames, runs the quarantine station at Heathrow Airport, and is the Port Health Authority for the whole of the Thames tidal estuary. Three premier wholesale food markets (Billingsgate, Spitalfields and Smithfield), which supply London and the South East with fresh produce, belong to the City of London. Large areas of open spaces in and around London, including Hampstead Heath and Epping Forest, are also managed by the City. In addition it supports the Arts e.g. the Barbican and the Guildhall School of MusicandDrama(GSMD).

[4] The City of London's approach to its Guidance Document

As noted above, the City of London undertakes many functions, both public and private. The City of London is only a public authority for the purposes of the FOIA in relation to some of these functions. The obligations set out under the FOIA extend to the Court of Common Council of the City of London in respect of information held its capacity as local authority, police authority and port health authority only. In addition, information held by the governing body of the GSMD Senior School, the operation of which is a function of the City of London, is also subject to the FOIA. As

stated above, in addition to these responsibilities the City of London performs a number of publicand private functions which fall outside the scope of the FOIA.

The City of London, as a local authority, police authority and port health authority, and in respect of the GSMD Senior School, is committed to complying with the Information Commissioner's Model Publication Scheme. As mentioned, the Information Commissioner has stated that a guidance document "could be a website, a spreadsheet [or] a leaflet." The City of London has chosen to retain its former Publication Scheme (which existed prior to the institution of the Model Publication Scheme by the Information Commissioner on 1 January 2009) as a Guidance Document. Our website, of course, also provides comprehensive informationconcerning the Cityof London.

In addition to information which falls under the FOIA, the City of London has chosen, at its sole discretion and with reference to the public interest, to include, in this Guidance Document, information which relates to functions which fall outside the scope of the FOIA. This approach has been adopted to provide the public with one resourceas to the information published by the City of London.

As such, the layout of this Guidance Document does not follow precisely the specific layout of 'classes' provided in the Model, but retains a structure which reflects the City'suniquediversity.

The City of London, as a local authority, police authority and port health authority, and in respect of the GSMD Senior School, is committed to working towards complying with the Information Commissioner's definition documents (mentioned above).

Please note that three bodies usually associated with the City of London are <u>not</u> included in this Guidance Document because, under the FOIA, they are separate legal entities for the purpose of complying with the Act. These bodies are:

[5] Some basic facts about the Guidance Document

We provide his Guidance Document in a number of formats including:

- inpaper format,
- on the City of London website at www.cityoflondon.gov.uk (from which a printableversion is available), or

• in alternative formats, which may be subject to the payment of a fee to cover the costs incurred (please contact the Public Relations Office).

Certain qualifying terms have been used in the Descriptions, as follows:

- **Published** created withspecific intention of being for publicuse.
- **Approved -** approved by elected Members under a formal decision-making process, or byofficers under delegated powers.
- **Draft** not formally approved.
- **Current** information which is accurate and available at the time of request.
- Historical-superseded current information retained for archival purposes.
- **Selected** indicates that the information included in the class is limited/indicatesthat the class is not comprehensive.
- **Exempt** material coming within the definition of the FOIA or other legislationas being exempt information.

Where information comes within an exempt category in the FOIA, it will be published with the exempt material deleted.

[6] How we make information available

Information listed in this Guidance Document will be made available in a number of ways. Note that information is not necessarily made available in all these ways; see individual Descriptions for details of which options are available. Where several categories of availability are listed, eg post, website and public access, it may only be possible make the information available in one of these formats.

• **Website**: When information is available on the City of London website the primary web address is www.cityoflondon.gov.uk. Note that if a link is given to another organisation's website, provision of the information is the responsibility of that organisationand not of the City of London.

• <u>**By post</u>**: Information will be posted on request, following receipt of a fee, if any (see below). Please use the contact details below to send your request. We aim to despatch the information within 10 working days from receipt of your request and the fee. We do not provide printouts from other organisations' websites.</u>

• <u>**By email**</u>: Material not on the website, where practicable, may be made available viaemail.

• **Public Access at City of London Offices (as set out in this Guidance Document or on our website):** Information is also available from City of London departments as set out in the departmental contact information below. You may need to make an appointment. Where information that is available for consultation can also be copied but is not immediately available for collection, we aim to despatch the informationrequested within 10 working days from receipt of your request.

• **City of London Research Services:** Free access to original records (or to copies of original records) is available through our library and archive search rooms. We may charge a fee to carry out the research necessary to tell you whether or not we hold specific information. We also charge for copies of documents. Most records are available for general access but some will be closed in whole or part because we are not required to make them available (i.e. they fall outside the scope of the FOIA) and do not wish to do so, or otherwise information in them is exempt information under the FOIA or the Data Protection Act 1998. Closures are usually indicated in our cataloguesand will be reviewed on request. There isno charge for this review.

• **Independent Research Services:** If your enquiry relates to records likely to be available for general access we also provide the names of independent researchers who, on payment of a fee agreed with you, will undertake this research.

[7] Charges

Some information is available free; for others a charge may be levied (see also [6]). The charges will vary according to how information is made available, which is specified for each Description within this Guidance Document, or on our website. Charges are subject ongoing review.

In broad termsthe followingconditionsapply:

- Website: free of chargeunless otherwise specified
- **Email:** free of charge unlessotherwise specified
- Material printed from the website at City of London public access terminals: a charge may be levied to cover the cost of printing, plus postage.
- Other material made available through public access terminals: a charge may be levied for the provision of this service.
- **Photocopies of requested information:** a reasonable photocopying charge may be levied.
- **Publications produced by the City of London for sale:** as per cover price. Charges willbe kept under review.

[8] Copyright

Information is protected by copyright unless otherwise indicated. You are not allowed to duplicate any materials you have obtained from the City of London through the Publication Scheme and Guidance Document unless the City of London has given you permission in writing. We may charge you a fee.

Some material available through the Scheme may be the copyright of a third party. Our right to hold and use such material do not extend to others. You must obtain authorisation form the copyright holder(s) concerned if you wish to copy or reproducesuchmaterial.

[9] Changes to the Guidance Document

The version of this Guidance Document which is on our Internet site (www.cityoflondon.gov.uk) is the master version, and it has the date of update on the front page. It is kept under ongoing review and new material of interest to people is added, particularly with the aim of complying with the Information Commissioner's best practice guidance in its definition documents. However, information will not necessarily be available indefinitely. Information may become unavailable in accordance with current retention policies, which are also kept under review.

[10] Access to your Personal Information

The Data Protection Act 1998 ('the DPA') provides individuals with a right of access to personal information held about them. The right is subject to exemptions that will affect whether information is provided and requests will be dealt with on a case by case basis. Requests for your own personal information fall under the DPA and not under the FOIA. Please send requests for access to your own personal information ('subject access requests') to the InformationOfficer (see [13]).

[11] Access to Environmental Information

Environmental information is usually made available to the public under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs) not the FOIA. However, for practical purposes such information is also described in our Guidance Document, and requests for environmental information can also be sent to the Information Officer (see [13]).

[12] Complaints and appeals

If you are not satisfied with the way we have managed your request, with the fee we have charged, or with the reasons we have given for refusing to provide information, you have the right to complain using our FOI complaints procedure, which can be found at www.cityoflondon.gov.uk. Your initial complaint should be sent in writing, either to the officer designated in our response to your request or to the InformationOfficer (see [13]).

If you are dissatisfied with the outcome of your complaint to us, you may then complain to the Information Commissioner. The Information Commissioner is

responsible for enforcing the operation of the FOIA (and the EIRs). Appeals to the InformationCommissioner should be sent to :
