







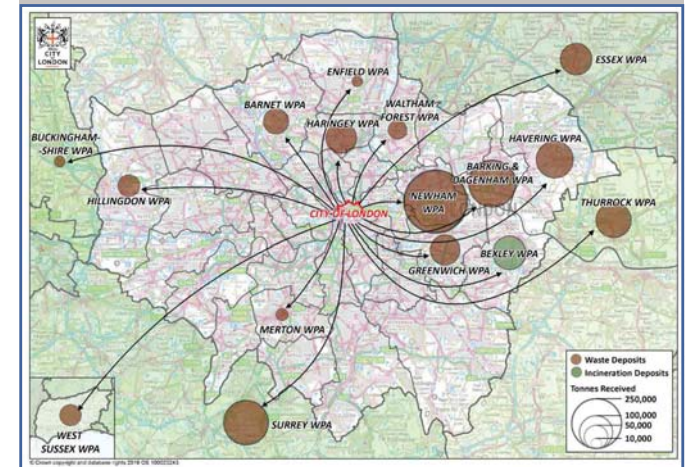


The City produced over 1.5 million tonnes of waste between 2010 and 2014. Most of this waste was managed elsewhere in London and south east England. Household and commercial waste is transported by river from Walbrook Wharf but construction waste goes mainly by road.

- Should we carry on relying on waste management facilities elsewhere?
- Should we continue to safeguard Walbrook Wharf as a waste site?

City businesses recycle about 70% of their commercial waste but we could do more to reduce waste in the first place.

- Should we promote on-site management of waste for large developments? How might that be achieved?
- How can we reduce waste associated with development and construction?
