Guidance on City of London Waiting & Loading Restrictions

Where can I stop to load and unload?

- Within dedicated loading bays
- On single and double yellow lines when no loading ban is in force
- In Pay & Display bays

When stopping to load / unload from your commercial vehicle, continuous loading activity must be apparent, otherwise a PCN may be issued. In the City, you can load / unload commercial vehicles for up to 40 minutes.

City of London loading signs

Where loading is completely prohibited at all times, the wording "No loading at any time" is used. This means that loading may not occur at any time ever on the stretch of street to which that sign indicates. Where loading is occasionally permitted there is a sign typically using such wording as "No Loading, Mon – Fri, 7am – 7pm". This sign means that there is no loading within the times stated, but out of that time loading is permitted for the duration of the "loading period".

Bus lanes

Bus lanes may be used for loading where it is not prohibited.

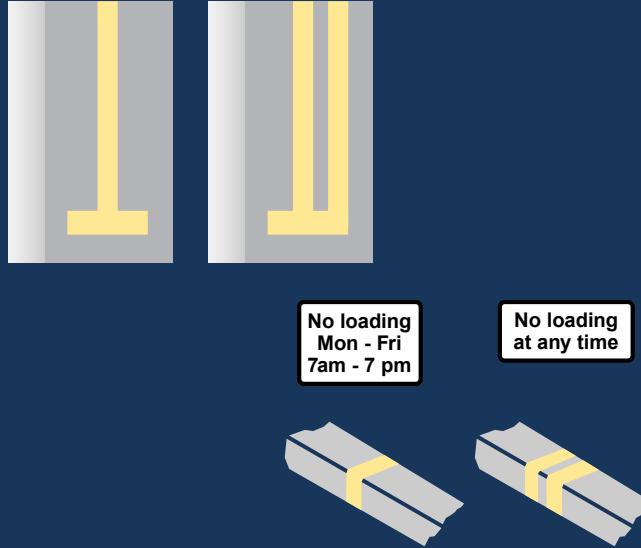
Places of no loading

Loading must not occur at the following locations:

1. Within 10 metres of a junction unless in an authorised space
2. On a crossing
3. On any zig-zag lines regardless of colour (such as around a Zebra crossing or "keep clear" sign)
4. Red routes mean no loading, unless special provision is given
5. Where the vehicle is causing an obstruction

Single and double yellow lines

These indicate that waiting restrictions are in place. Commercial vehicle drivers are permitted to load/unload on both single and double yellow lines for up to 40 minutes unless there is a loading ban in force. Loading bans are indicated by kerb markings.



Where single and double yellow lines are accompanied by TWO kerb markings you cannot stop or load / unload at any time in any vehicle. Where single and double yellow lines are accompanied by ONE kerb marking you cannot stop or load / unload from any commercial vehicle during the times that the ban is in force (indicated on a nearby sign).

Where yellow lines are NOT accompanied by ANY kerb markings

All commercial vehicles are allowed to load and unload but limited to a maximum of 40 minutes.

Royal Mail

Vehicles displaying the Royal Mail livery which are collecting or delivering mail can do so anywhere.
