Cousin Lane – No motor vehicles restriction

The City of London (Prohibited and Compulsory Movements) (Amendment No. 12) Order 2017

The City of London (Prescribed Routes) (Road Closure) (Amendment No. 5) Order 2017

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of London on 6 December 2017 made the above Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the Orders in Cousin Lane will be to make permanent the provisions of The City of London (Cousin Lane) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2017 namely to prohibit motor vehicles 'at any time' except for access and exempt pedal cycles from the compulsory left turn into Upper Thames Street.
3. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 18 December 2017, of the statement of reasons for making the Orders and of a plan showing the affected street can be inspected during normal office hours on Monday to Fridays inclusive within a period of 6 months from the date on which the Order came into operation at the Planning Enquiry Desk, North Wing, Guildhall, London, EC2P 2EJ.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
